## [Survey of Texas Camp 2015: The results are in!](#) *by Misi Tsurikov*

Thank you to everyone who completed a survey at Texas Camp 2015. This survey is vital to keeping Texas Camp healthy and serving its attendees. We use its results to keep what was good and improve what was not good.

This year, we collected 61 responses, corresponding to a response rate of 42% (down from 50% last year). (The free-response comments are not published to preserve anonymity.)

The highlights of the survey are as follows:

- Camp 2015 was well-liked.
- Both Mihai and Campbell received praise for their teaching. Campbell Miller was especially well-liked.
- Shirleys singing classes and subsequent performers were well-liked and praised.
- Our campers again liked the Camp delights, even if they didn't attend all of the delights.
- The quality of sound for teaching sessions, live music, and recorded music was very good.
- The schedule worked very well.
- Live music was very well-liked and high-quality.
- The Family Support Program was highly ranked and praised.

The survey identified a few areas that were ranked lower than before:

- The sound quality during mealtime announcements
- The food quality and quantity
- The quality of housing

The survey also revealed that the top three requested dance styles for next year's Texas Camp were:

- TIE: General international mix and Turkish (50%)
- Bulgarian (44%)
- Scandinavian (39%)

- Frequently-requested teachers for next year's Texas Camp were:

- Lee Otterholt
- Ahmet Lüleci
- Alex Markovic
